We aim to provide an environment safe from the risk of fire and address an outbreak of fire in a manner to minimize its effects.

Please familiarize yourself with the fire exits on your ward.

- Elevators not to be used during any emergency.
- In the event of any emergency, exit plans are located at all floors and units.
- Fire exit staircases located in all areas of the hospital shall be used during any fire emergency.
- If you are physically determined, our hospital is equipped with the evacuation equipment, ask for the assistance.

The hospital periodically conducts fire drills to ensure patient safety and staff efficiency in the event of a real emergency. The sound of the fire alarm may be because of drill purposes; but always listen carefully to the instructions being announced on the public address

system or unit staff. Please remain calm as all of our staff is completely trained on fire safety procedures.

In the event of a suspected fire, the alarms will sound continuously or intermittently until the situation is assessed and controlled. Please wait for instructions if it is necessary for you to evacuate the area you are in. In the event of a fire, please cooperate with instructions issued by the safety representative or department in-charge.

IF YOU DISCOVER OR SUSPECT A FIRE:

- Raise the alarm by activating the fire alarm call point
- Inform a Security personal if available or any of the unit staff member.
- Obey the instructions of safety representative or department in-charge.
- Leave the building by the nearest emergency exit if instructed so.



IF YOU HEAR A FIRE ALARM:

- Be calm and pay attention to the public address system's announcement.
- If you are safe from the fire location, wait for the further assistance.
- Be alert and follow the specific instructions given by the safety representative or department in-charge.

SELF-PROTECTION DURING A FIRE DISASTER:

- If you are entrapped in a room which is filled with smoke, please cover your face with wet cloth (if available) and crawl towards exit.
- Follow the emergency exit light towards safe evacuation.
- Obey the instructions given by the staff or safety representative or security personal.

THINGS YOU HAVE TO BE ADHERE TO KEEP THE PREMISES FREE FROM FIRE HAZARDS:

- · Always follow no smoking policy.
- · Do not overload the electrical sockets.
- Always ensure the electrical appliances free from moistures.
- Keep the flammable materials away from heat source or direct sunlight.

Do not use the lifts. Do not re-enter the building until it is declared safe to enter.
