









## **PROCEDURE**

The tube is divided and closed to allow the fluid, which has collected in the sac of the testicle to drain normally.

## **RISKS OF THIS PROCEDURE**

There are some risks/ complications, which can include:

- (a) Rarely, the fluid remains after the surgery and further surgery may be necessary.
- (b) In male children, the testicle and the contents of the scrotum may swell due to tissue damage or bleeding.
- (c) The testicle may be damaged and may shrink up in size after the operation.
